### Daniel:

Having eyes they see not; For the God of this world hate blinded their eye and concealed the truth from them...

Just as Daniel was positioned to speak so is the Lord desiring to establish His ways in the earth.

Nebuchadnezzar is a type of the condition of the mind, "that is set" that we have to deal with...

A false sense of relationship with God... Full of Pride Deceived by Victories

Nebuchadnezzar son of Nabopolazzar his father who was wicked, names his son... The name, **Nabû-kudurri-uṣur**, meaning "O god <u>Nabu</u>, preserve/defend my firstborn son".

Nebuchadnezzar therefor styles himself as The "beloved" and "favorite

Nebuchadnezzar despite his pride had a destiny prescribed by God however he choose unwisely to follow the wicked prideful DNA that was in his genes...

### **But Daniel**

At the close of his three years of discipline and training in the royal schools, Daniel was distinguished for his proficiency in the "wisdom" of his day, and was brought out into public life. He soon became known for his skill in the interpretation of dreams (1:17; 2:14), and rose to the rank of governor of the province of Babylon, and became "chief of the governors" (Chaldean: Rab-signin) over all the wise men of Babylon. He made known and also interpreted Nebuchadnezzar's dream; and many years afterwards, when he was now an old man, amid the alarm and consternation of the terrible night of Belshazzar's impious feast, he was called in at the instance of the queen-mother (perhaps Nitocris, the daughter of Nebuchadnezzar) to interpret the mysterious handwriting on the wall. He was rewarded with a purple robe and elevation to the rank of "third ruler." The place of "second ruler" was held by Belshazzar as associated with his father, Nabonidus, on the throne (5:16). Daniel interpreted the handwriting, and "in that night was Belshazzar the king of the Chaldeans slain."

Begin end time apostasy

Apostasy - A departure from religion

In the end times there will be a great falling away.

### 2 Thessalonians 2:3

Let no man deceive you by any means; for that day shall not come, except there come a falling away first...

There is a matter much like what happened to Nebuchadnezzar, that a troublesome thing is happening that is disturbing to the nations yet they have no understanding nor interpretation.

It is so bothersome that rest is taken from them...

But the answer is with those who have already set themselves apart.

Those who have already positioned themselves for the reveal...

Those children of God who know the revelation or how to get the revelation.

We are in the end times the end of days as we know them...

And we must understand the times that have prophesied. We must recognize or we will make wrong judgements based on wrong interpretations.

Lets look at one of Daniels prophecies that I believe we are seeing manifested today. One that I believe the apostles must address.

Daniel speaks of the abomination of desolation standing in the Holy Place...

# Daniel 11:31

"And they shall pollute the sanctuary of strength and shall take away the daily (sacrifice) and shall place the abomination that maketh desolate.

There are a few things to note here:

The pollution of the sanctuary...

Calling those things that were once holly now unnecessary

Replacing holy requirements with common place things...

Neglecting the house of God and the servants of God and making them common

No reverence for holy days "Remember the Sabbath Day to keep it Holy"

The removal of the daily...

What was once required as a daily living in now replaced with once a week living. On Sunday only...

The abomination is that which is disgusting, filthy, idolatrous detestable

Desolate - to stun growth, to stupefy, make dumb, to devastate to the point of non growth. to put into a state of little or no sensibility...
